Below please find some important updates for the start of school:

Please pick-up your child's school supplies at Riley School this Friday, August 28<sup>th</sup> or on Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. The address for school supply pick-up is 5650 Mt. Ackerly Drive, San Diego, 92117, in the Clairemont neighborhood. Supplies for all students, including students attending Marcy and New Dawn High Schools need to please pick-up at this location.

In addition, communication has gone out to parents from the district that our students are required to go to one particular school site to pick-up school breakfast/lunch meals. This is not the case for our students! All of our students qualify for free meals, no need for any parents to complete any meal applications.
